

## Standard Based Grading (SBG) and SBG Report Cards 3rd Grade Pilot Year 2018-19

- During Back to School Conferences, 3rd grade teachers introduced Standard Based Grading and Report Cards to parents and guardians.
- During fall conferences, 3rd grade teachers used SBG Report Cards and followed up with a feedback survey. They sent the survey to the parent/guardian email group they use for correspondence.

### Results of Survey

There are 115 students in 3rd grade and 23 students per class.

There were 37 responses to the survey

- 5 from Mr. Jensen's class
- 5 from Mrs. Ulrich's class
- 8 from Mrs. Schiminkey's class
- 9 from Mr. Bloomquist's class
- 10 from Mrs. Hansen's class

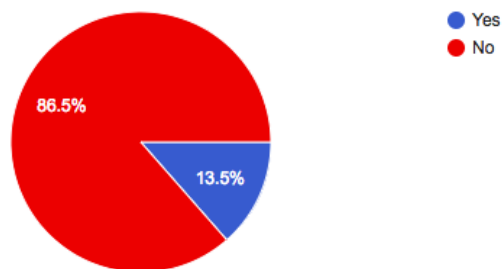
### Questions on Survey:

What are your first thoughts about Standard-Based Reporting?

- There were 16 statements in support, 6 statements that were neutral or with question, and 11 negative.

Do you have any questions, both new or clarifying, that you would like addressed?

What questions do you have?

- There were 5 responses. Questions were about how this works for grading, wondering if this is the direction the entire district is going and what this looks like for when kids apply for college, stretching students to their fullest as well as what will happen if a student doesn't master all the standards by the end of the year.

Looking forward, what information would you have liked to have earlier?

- There were 19 responses.
  - There were 7 questions about why the change and grading.
  - There were 6 questions about wanting to know how their child was doing during the quarter through daily work.
  - There were 4 statements saying they didn't have anything.
  - There were 2 statements about understanding this however have concerns of what is being taught, taught to the test, and that higher learners are being neglected.
